Guidelines for Submission of Practical-II Journal

- It shall be the responsibility of the individual student that he/she shall mail the assignment to the email address mentioned below:

- The file shall be in pdf format and shall be sent in the email address mentioned above only.
- Submission of all the topics should be sent in one attachment.
- The assignment should be handwritten only.
Clear Scaaned images of the handwritten journal should be mailed to kclcatktinternal@gmail.com on or before the prescribed date for online submission
- The assignment must be of minimum 8 and maximum 10 pages of Standard A4 sized paper.
- Cover Page shall contain the Roll Number and Names of the Topics written in the journal



Note :

- Written Examination shall be for 75 marks and the duration shall be 150 minutes (2 and a half hours)
- The written examination shall comprise of a total of eight questions out of which any five questions are to be attempted. Each question shall carry 15 marks
